#### Expressive Arts and Design

- Construct by joining objects together and describe how you made it
- Make a model of a church and/or mosque using different construction materials
- Role play different peoples jobs

### Communication and Language

- Think of questions to ask visitors to share their experiences of their jobs.
- Talk about people who help us at home and in our community
- Ask each other questions and respond to others' wishes
- Listen one to one or in small groups & focus attention.
- Explain our ideas and ask questions

## Physical Development

- Practise hand-eye coordination, strength & control when using scissors & writing implements.
- Practise dynamic balance on a line
- Practise a static balance stance
- To use scissors to cut along a straight and curved line
- Hold a writing tool correctly to form letters and numbers

# Religious Education

- Which places are specially valued and why?
- To name a special place their own
- To talk about why some places are special, what makes them important and why people like to go and what they like to do there.
- To know the church as a special place for Christians and a mosque as a special place for Muslims.
- Visit a local place of worship.
- Create a special place in the inside/outside area or wider school grounds. A space for guiet reflection

Key vocabulary: church, spire, stained glass window, bells. Mosque, dome, minaret
