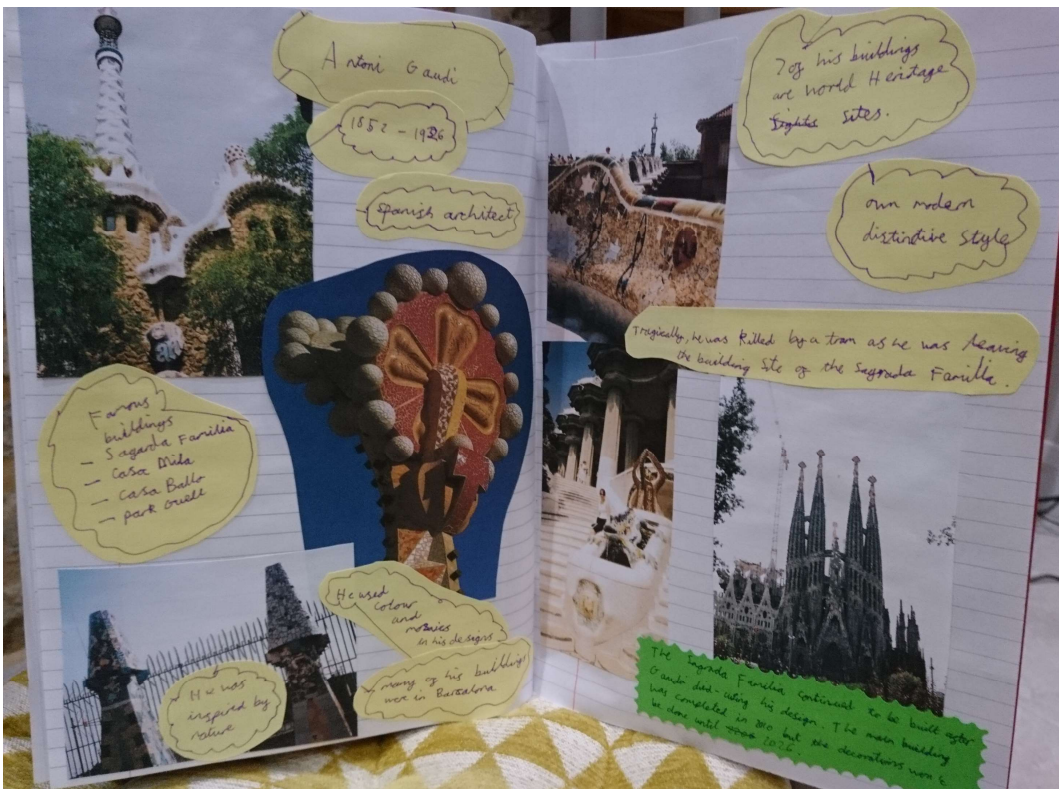
My Viking village
