Christmas Cards

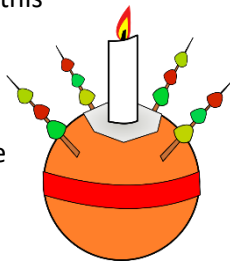
