Money

I know the coin and note values we use.

I can find total amounts by adding coins and notes.

I know which operation to choose to solve simple word problems involving money.

Multiplication and division

I know how to count on in multiples of 2, 3, 5, 10.

I know 2x, 5x and 10x multiplication and division facts.

Length and height

I know that 100cm = 1m.

I can compare and measure length and height in cm and m.

Mass, capacity & temperature

I know that mass is measured in grams and kilograms.

I know that millilitres and litres can be used to measure the volume of a liquid.

I know that temperature is measured in degrees Celsius. I can read simple scales.

I can use strategies learned to confidently add and subtract in order to solve simple problems.
